Its purpose is to train the soul, which is the seat of the mind, will, and emotions, to love that which is worth loving.

Curriculum

Covenant Classical School offers a curriculum with a unique emphasis on the intellectual skills and habits that prepare the student for life-long learning. The course of study is based on the Trivium: grammar, logic, and rhetoric. The first six years concentrate on the grammar of the subjects: their structure and objective characteristics. The middle years emphasize the logic or relationships of these characteristics. The final years bring out the student's creative and synthetic capabilities through the art of rhetoric, leading him to master and communicate what he has learned.
