### THE SCHOOL

Covenant Classical School, founded in 1996, is an independent co-educational day school. Covenant Classical School is dedicated to providing a Christian and classical liberal arts education to boys and girls in kindergarten through twelfth grade. The 16-acre campus is located in Concord, North Carolina.

### MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of Covenant Classical School is to provide an education of excellence, biblically based and classically taught, that will lead students to know and love God, develop strong intellect and character, and arise as leaders and agents of cultural change.

### CLASSICAL CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

Classical Christian education is the cultivation of virtue and wisdom by nourishing the soul on truth, goodness, and beauty according to God's Revelation using the classical liberal arts. Its purpose is to train the soul, which is the seat of the mind, will, and emotions, to love that which is worth loving.

### CURRICULUM

Covenant Classical School offers a curriculum with a unique emphasis on the intellectual skills and habits that prepare the student for life-long learning. The course of study is based on the Trivium: grammar, logic, and rhetoric. The first six years concentrate on the grammar of the subjects: their structure and objective characteristics. The middle years emphasize the logic or relationships of these characteristics. The final years bring out the student's creative and synthetic capabilities through the art of rhetoric, leading the student to master and communicate what has been learned.
