Purple - Royal majesty, sovereignty and justice.

SYMBOLS:

Lion - Deathless courage

Bear - Ferocity in the protection of kindred

Elephant - Courage and strength

Lamb - Gentleness and patience under suffering

Beaver - Industry and perseverance

Swan - A lover of poetry and harmony

Dove - Loving constancy and peace

Crow - Signifies a settled habitation and quiet life
