Answer each question in cursive in complete sentences.

1. The title of the book is _____.
2. Who is the author of the book, and does he write from a biblical worldview or a non-biblical worldview? In other words, is there an indication that the author views life from a Christian perspective? Give examples to support your conclusion.
3. What is the setting of the story? Include date, span of time (days, months, years) and place.
4. Identify the main characters. Additionally, name the protagonist and antagonist if applicable.
5. Discuss the conflict within the story. Include the following examples when relevant:

Character vs. character

Character vs. nature

Character vs. self
6. What is the highest point of dramatic intensity, or climax, of the story?
7. How is the conflict resolved?
8. Authors use literary devices to provide imagery. Include examples of simile, metaphor, personification, alliteration, oxymoron, onomatopoeia, pun, irony, etc. Write the example and page number of your find. All the choices may not be included in your book.

9. On a separate sheet of paper write a well-organized paragraph of 10 –15 sentences summarizing the plot of your book.
10. Include a list of unfamiliar vocabulary words that you encounter in your reading. Write the word, part of speech, and definition. (ten minimum)

Extra Credit: Begin your seventh grade year with extra points in English. In addition to reading your book choice, read both books on the list. You do not need to take the book quiz on the extra book; however, you will need to follow the directions for writing the paragraph, number 9, on the additional book that you read.
