Lands' End Preferred School Number: 900100140 (Please create a free account or be sure to update your existing account.)

*For items not specifically listed as “Lands’ End” on the chart, identical items matching in color, fabric, and style to our school’s Lands’ End Uniforms may be purchased at other vendors.

*All uniforms must be clean, neat, well-fitting, and in good repair.

*If not following the dress code, students may be required to change.

*The parents are responsible for ensuring their student complies with the CCS dress code policy. Enforcement begins at home before the school day begins. If in doubt about the dress code, please ask the Administration.

*Recess: Any outerwear can be worn during recess time. If the outerwear does not comply with the Dress Code, said outerwear will need to be removed in the classroom.

*When do I need a collared shirt? Any pullover item without a collar needs a polo shirt or Oxford under it. If it has a collar or is a complete button-up front (like a sweater), the essential T is fine to wear under it.

Tops	<p>*Boys and Girls: Polos and Lands’ End Essential T in black, white, gray, or red - short or long sleeve. Essential T's must have the CCS "School Name" logo.</p> <p>*Oxfords in white or blue - short or long sleeve.</p> <p>*Must have one Lands’ End black polo with CCS “School Name” logo for Chapel (every Thursday).</p>	<p>Bottoms: Pants/Shorts Chino Material Only</p>	<p>*Girls: pants, skirt, skort, jumper, or dress (biker shorts recommended under skirts, dress, and jumper).</p> <p>*Boys: Shorts or pants—a brown or black belt must be worn (1st-6th), and shirts tucked in (JK-6th).</p> <p>*See colors and styles approved at our Lands' End store.</p> <p>*Must have 1 set of Khaki bottoms for Chapel.</p>	<p>*Tops should not have vendor logos.</p> <p>*Shorts should be no more than 2" above the knee.</p> <p>*Skirts should be no more than 1" above the knee, measured from the back of the knee.</p>
Footwear	<p>*Socks: Must be black, gray, red, khaki, or white with no visible patterns. This includes tights and leggings.</p> <p>*Shoes: They must be primarily one of the following colors: black, brown, red, gray, or white, and without distracting patterns. They should also be conducive to P.E. and outside play. No Crocs (or Croc-like shoes). *Nice sandals may be worn on non-P.E. days, no heels.</p>	<p>Accessories</p>	<p>*Hair Accessories: Must be solid color, match top colors, and be removable. No fairy hair.</p> <p>*Tights and leggings: They must be solid in color—black, red, grey, khaki, or white—and free of patterns or lace.</p> <p>*Ties (optional): solid black or Land's End tie.</p>	<p>*No light-up shoes or Heelys.</p> <p>*No graphics or "word art"</p> <p>*No bandanas or temporary/permanent hair additions.</p>

Warm Attire for the Classroom	<p>*See Lands' End for options. Black Sweatshirt must have CCS "School Name" logo. No hoodies worn in the classroom except on Fridays. Hoodies may be worn outside.</p> <p>*Polo or Oxford must be worn under pullover crewneck or V-neck sweatshirts, sweaters, and vests. Button-up sweaters and fleeces can have an Essential T under them.</p>	PE Wear	*Not required.	
Spirit Wear	<p>*CCS Spirit top (shirt, long sleeve, sweater, or hoodies) with plain blue jeans. Crocs may be worn.</p> <p>These can only be worn on Fridays.</p>	Student Events	*Follow modesty guidelines of shorts no more than 2" above the knee, and loose-fitting or PE shorts may be purchased. T-shirts may be worn instead of uniform shirts.	
Grooming	<p>*Hair: All students should keep their hair neatly groomed and inconspicuously styled. Hair must be kept out of the eyes to not interfere with eye contact and line of vision. Hair colors and patterns that do not naturally occur on people are not permitted. No fairy hair.</p> <p>*Boys: Hair should not cover the eyebrows or shirt collar, and the side length should be no longer than mid-ear.</p> <p>*Visible markings on the body are not allowed.</p>			<p>*Boys: hair accessories may not be worn; mohawks, "man buns", shaved to baldheads, and boys' ponytails are unacceptable.</p> <p>*Girls: no body piercings (minimal and non-distracting ear piercings are allowed) and no heavy/unusual makeup.</p> <p>Updated 5/29/2025</p>
